The goal at Hunter Plastic Surgery is to help make the choices clear and take away some of the anxiety women feel about choosing a more confident future.

While Dr Moncrieff is an expert in breast enhancement and reduction, tummy tucks and body lifts, this focus sits perfectly with their range of non-surgical options, including

fat freezing, cosmetic injections and laser.

"Sitting nicely alongside our surgical practice is our Renew Medispa. As Australian leaders in fat freezing, we are able to offer expert body sculpting as well as honest advice when surgery would be more appropriate. We also offer facial rejuvenation through laser, chemical peels, medical-grade skincare and of course, cosmetic injections," says Moncrieff.

Hunter Plastic Surgery is no stranger to the non-surgical fat-reduction market. The clinic has performed more than 2,000 cryolipolysis treatments, with a satisfaction rate of over 98%. Recently, the clinic has introduced Cooltech to its Renew Medispa, with impressive results.
